



## Cystic Fibrosis Dietitian & Social Worker Consortium

### Re-Certification

Certification is valid for 3 years from the approval date. To be eligible for recertification, individuals must be an active Registered Dietitian with the Commission of Dietetic Registration or a body determined to be equivalent if not located in the United States, and also completed one of the following within the last 3 years:

- Served as a mentor on the CFF Nutrition mentoring program or through Mentor Connect
- Served as a workshop moderator at NACFC
- Published a cystic fibrosis related chapter or article in a peer-reviewed journal
- Provided an oral presentation on a cystic fibrosis nutrition topic at a state/regional/national conference
- Provided a state/regional/national webinar presentation on a cystic fibrosis nutrition-related topic
- Primary author on a cystic fibrosis nutrition-related poster at a state/regional/national conference
- Written an article related to CF nutrition in a national publication or website (not peer-reviewed)
- Served on a national committee related to cystic fibrosis or cystic fibrosis nutrition for a minimum of 1 year
- Complete a minimum of 35 cystic fibrosis-specific CEUs

Cystic fibrosis-specific education includes the following:

Any offering from the Cystic Fibrosis Dietitian & Social Work Consortium or other cystic fibrosis organization such as:

Cystic Fibrosis Foundation (CFF)  
European Cystic Fibrosis Society (ECFS)  
Cystic Fibrosis Australia (CFA)  
Mid-Atlantic Cystic Fibrosis Consortium

and/or

Any offering from a nutrition or medical organization specific to CF nutrition or CF dietitian practices, including, but not limited to:

The Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics  
American Society of Enteral and Parenteral Nutrition (ASPEN)  
Dietitians in Nutrition Support

and/or

Any offering that provides Category 1 CME approved credits on a CF-specific topic

The Cystic Fibrosis Dietitian and Social Work Consortium Nutrition Workgroup will accept any of these educational offerings regardless of whether they have been approved by bodies like the Commission on Dietetic Registration (CDR).

Participation/attendance certificates are required for all CF-specific CEUs.
